
# REI **QUARTER DOME UL**

## SETUP INSTRUCTIONS



## CHECK INSIDE THE TENT BAG FOR:

- Tent body and rainfly
- Pole bag and stake bag
- 4 guylines with tighteners
- 2 poles 6 stakes





## PITCHING THE TENT

- Lay out tent. (If it's windy out, stake down floor.)
- Grab either pole's red end and, starting at the orange front corner tab, insert it in the pole sleeve; push gently until the tip reaches the sleeve's dead end at the opposite tent corner.
- Do the same with the other pole; then set both exposed pole tips into the front corner tabs' outer grommets.
- If you didn't do it yet, you can relocate and stake tent down for greater stability.

### ATTACHING THE FLY

- Drape rainfly over the tent so that the orange tabs on the fly and tent body align.
- On underside of fly, attach hook-and-loop tabs to pole sleeves (4 places on front sleeves, 2 places on rear).
- Buckle rainfly to tent at all corners. Tighten all buckles.
- Stake each vestibule loop down and pull cord through cleat until taut; then wedge cord into the cleat's slot to "lock" in place (see above).

### TIGHTENER

- Increase ventilation by unzipping and rolling up fly.
- Tension fly by tightening buckles and/or vestibule cleats.
- Using extra guylines in wind: 1) Tie free end of guyline to a guyout point on the fly.
  - 2) Pull a loop of line out from the tightener.
  - 3) Stake down the loop and slide tightener toward the flv (see above). Additional stakes sold separately

NOTE: To speed setup next time, leave rainfly attached to tent during take-down (unless it's wet).
